



Ski Lift Rescue Operations Course

The Course- The course is a 16 hour class which contains 4 hours of lecture (covering Applicable Standards, Lock Out/ Tagout procedures, Ski Lift types and parts, Creating and managing Lift Evacuation plans and procedures and entanglement and entrapment problems), 4 hours of hands on skill stations (knots, operations of rope rescue equipment, haul systems and anchor systems) and 8 hours of hands on skills involving actual ski lifts (personal evacuation techniques, ascending ropes, ascending lift towers, assisted evacuation techniques and technical evacuation techniques). The Patrollers will be exposed to some of the most modern lift rescue equipment from individuals who have extensive experience and training in ski lift rescue. The participants will also see the downfalls of some of the equipment used in the past by ski patrols and resorts.

Who Should Attend- This course is beneficial to all Patrollers (from the newest to the most seasoned) as well as other resort employees that might be required to assist with lift rescue operations as part of their job requirements.

Prerequisites- There are no prerequisites for this course.
